Dja Dja Wurrung Time (Seasons)

Seasons are a Western concept that relate to weather changes over the year. There are four seasons which are generally called Spring, Summer, Autumn and Winter. In the Southern Hemisphere these are:

• Summer: December to February

Autumn: March to May

• Winter: June to August

• Spring: September to November

The Australian Aboriginal view of the world is that *Seasons* are in fact *Time* and are based upon the availability of resources.

Our native plants and animals provide visual indicators and there may also be specific weather type events, such as fogs and wind directional changes.

For Dja Dja Wurrung there are six times (seasons) directly relating to Country.

Baramul (Emu) and Milakuk (Lightning) Time (December-March)

Murnong (Yam Daisy) and Ngaari (Black Duck) Time (April)

Datimdatim (Boomerang) and Wai-kalk (Wattle) Time (May-June)

Wanyarra (Water) and Gurri (Kangaroo) Time (July-August)

Boyn (Bread) and Lawan (Mallee fowl) Time (September-October)

Giranul (Perch) and Wirrap (Cod) Time (November-December)

Barramul (Emu) and Milakuk (Lightning) Time

(Time of reverence)

December to March

Barramul, become pairs and after eggs hatch the male raises the young.

During this time many waterfowl begin to pair and ready for season courtship and mating laying of eggs allows an initial collection so as birds can lay again for hatching.

Cold and Wet time, creek, streams and now Rock Wells fill up. (Time of some abstinence and watching Gurri)



Grass Seed / Bread Time

(Lawan Mallee Fowl, Boyn Grass Season)

September - October



Yam daisy - It's time to eat the Tuber and seed becomes available. Yam daisy seed available until November



Breeding and Egg Collection Time

(Degrees of abstinence)
(Giranul Perch, Wirrap Murray Cod, Djarra-Djarritj Hard

Head) November - December
